



## An Introduction To The CTLA

17<sup>th</sup> October 1986 was the Incorporation date of our Association.

The Association was set up:

- To give the industry a strong united voice particularly with Govt. Departments and Industry
- To maintain a high and uniform standard in testing procedure.
- To afford protection to Members
- To accumulate and disseminate information to Members

There are two Membership options available:

- 'Full' – Shall be a person or organisation involved in Gas Cylinder Testing, shall have full voting rights, be eligible for election to the Committee and shall receive all information issued by the Association.
- 'Associate' – Shall be a person or organisation with an interest in Gas Cylinder Testing, shall NOT be eligible for election to the Committee nor have voting rights

Our annual AGM is held within the first 2 weeks of September and it is at this time that the following Membership Fees are set. Currently Full Membership \$550 and Associate Membership \$325 – prices include GST.

Once confirmation that you are a financial Member your access will be approved by the Administrator. There is a forum board on the website for Members to use to discuss matters that may arise within any test station.
